

Regulations of the EYEC Scientific Photo Contest

§1

General resolutions

1. The Organizers of the EYEC Scientific Photo Contest (hereafter called 'Contest') are the Students Scientific Group located at the Faculty of Chemical and Process Engineering, Warsaw University of Technology, Poland and Foundation of Young Science (hereafter called 'The Organizers').
2. The Contest starts on 16.01.2017 and finishes on 26.04.2017.

§2

Terms and conditions of participation in the Contest

1. Being a participant of the 6th European Young Engineers Conference is required to take part in the Contest.
2. The participation in the Contest includes publication of scientific image taken by the Participant on his/her Facebook or Twitter profile with hashtags: #EYEC2017 and #EYECscience.
3. Participation in the contest requires total fulfillment of the following conditions:
 - one person is able to publish one contest image
 - the image should depict result of the Participant's scientific work regarding main topics of the European Young Engineers Conference (process engineering; chemical engineering; process equipment; biomedical engineering; nanotechnologies & nanomaterials; bioprocess engineering; environment protection; material engineering; other engineering disciplines)
 - the image must not break the rights of intellectual property of other people
 - by publishing the image the Participant agrees to its publication and use by the editors of website: eyec.ichip.pw.edu.pl
 - the image should be published between 16.01.2017 – 26.04.2017 until 12.00 am, extension of the publication time is not predicted.

§3

Principles of assessment

1. The Jury of the Contest consists of Special Guests of the 6th European Young Engineers Conference.
2. The Jury will choose one image, considered to be the most interesting according to their scientific experience.

§4

Awards

1. The results of the Contest will be announced during the Ending Ceremony of the 6th European Young Engineers Conference on 26.04.2017.

2. The awards for the winner are provided by the Organizing Committee of the 6th European Young Engineers Conference.
3. The winning image will be published on the website: www.eyec.ichip.pw.edu.pl and shared on the European Young Engineers Conference Facebook fanpage and Twitter profile.

§5

Personal Details of Participants

1. All personal details provided by the Participants will be administrated by the Students Scientific Group, located in Warsaw (00-645), Waryńskiego 1 St. Data will be processed in order to carry out the Contest.
2. All data is protected according to law, using up-to-date safety devices.

§6

Rights of the Organizers

1. The Organizers reserve a right to publish and register materials connected to the course of the Contest and to make them third party accessible.

§7

Regulations changes

1. The Organizers reserve the exclusive right to make slight changes in the Regulations. Any changes in the Regulations must not encroach upon the rights of the Participants. The changes do not require justification from the Organizers.
2. Any information on possible changes in Regulations of the Contest itself will be immediately published on the European Young Engineers Conference website, Facebook fanpage and Twitter profile.

§8

Final Regulations

1. The Regulations are available in the office of the Organizers and on the European Young Engineers Conference website: www.eyec.ichip.pw.edu.pl.
2. The Organizers are not responsible for impossibility or difficulties of holding the Contest, owing to circumstances beyond their control, especially as following:
 - a. The failure or necessity of fixing unforeseen faults of the website;
 - b. Influence of a third party, disrupting the functioning of the website or course of the Contest.
3. The Organizers reserve the right to suspend, interrupt, prolong or cancel the Contest with prior informing the Participants.
4. In case of changing or cancelling/invalidating any part of these Regulations by the decision of qualified executives or magistrates, the remaining Regulations are still in force for the Organizers, as well as the Participants.
5. In any case not regulated by hereby Regulations, the Polish law should be applied.

6. Any doubts about the rules of the Contest and the provisions of the Regulations will be settled by the Organizers.
